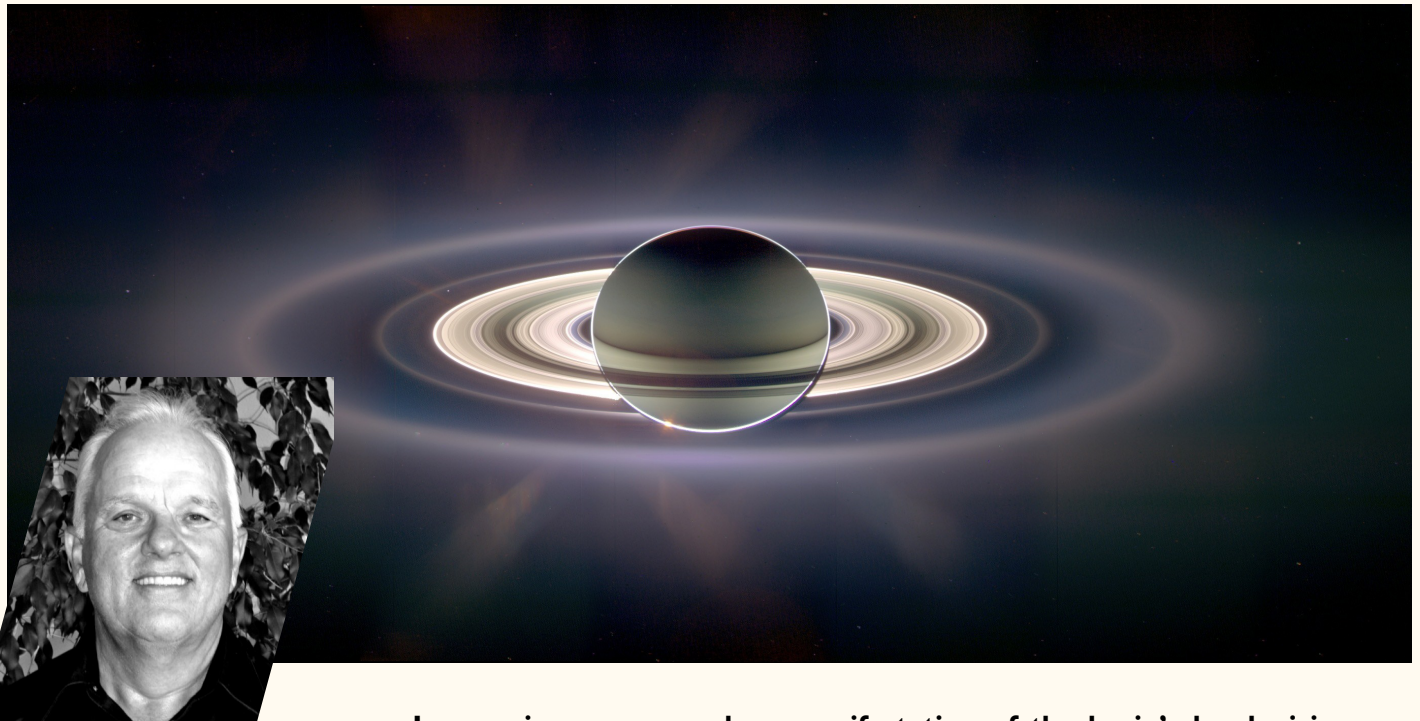
Part II: What is Consciousness?

Dr. William Jury is profoundly expert discussing both the physical and the metaphysical. With a Master's Degree in Spiritual Psychology and a PhD in Physics, he is uniquely qualified to show where these two worlds meet, how they differ, and how they may prove to ultimately be different aspects of each other.

Is consciousness merely a manifestation of the brain's hard-wiring, or does it exist on its own, independent of the body? This question, so fundamental to understanding ourselves, has intrigued humanity for centuries, but the answer has proved elusive. Researchers who dare to study consciousness and psychic phenomena, attempting to move us beyond existing paradigms of human behavior and abilities, can risk career suicide and ostracism by the mainstream scientific community.

Dr. Jury will openly discuss many of these fringe studies, on subjects ranging from the near-death experience, to the power of prayer, to testing intuition and our ability to predict (or even influence) outside events. The evidence is tantalizing and sometimes contradictory. Yet it ultimately demonstrates that a power exists within humans which is in conflict with conventional views of reality and natural law. How do these abilities work? What are the implications for our understanding of reality and the meaning of life? Join us as we search for the answers together.
